With the Berlin Peace Dialogue, the Advisory Board to the Federal Government for Civilian Crisis Prevention and Peacebuilding would like to focus on learning from experiences as a central component of responsible crisis prevention, conflict management and peacebuilding. Learning from experiences requires an honest approach to and communication of challenges and obstacles. The conference will discuss institutional learning processes from individual project monitoring to evaluations of major international engagements to possibilities for learning at the political level. The Berlin Peace Dialogue 2021 will feature insights from peace activists, international practitioners and policymakers that provide participants with actionable takeaways.
